Corpus Christi:



Have you ever heard the phrase “You are what you eat”? Normally, you hear it when someone is warning you not to eat junk food. If you eat unhealthy food, it is not good for your body. But if you eat and

drink healthy things, then you will hopefully be healthier!

At the Last Supper, Jesus gave his friends bread and wine, blessed them and said, “Take this and eat it”. We hear these words every time we listen to Mass in the Church or listen via the webcam. Maybe we just remember the Priest saying them the last time we attended the Church. Listen out for these words the next time we attend Mass in the Sacred Heart.....

When we receive the holy Bread and Wine of Communion, it is so much more than just bread and wine. It is now the Body and Blood of Christ. In this living Bread is all the goodness of Jesus and all that Jesus wants us to be.

In today’s Gospel for the feast of Corpus Christi, Jesus talks about his body that will be broken and his blood that will be poured out. It is this “broken” Jesus that we meet in the Eucharist, and who meets us in our broken state. It is this broken Jesus who is present in all of us, and who challenges us to love the broken people we meet.

Following Jesus is a total lifelong commitment. Lord, I’m not worthy to receive you but only say the word and my soul will be healed. The Eucharist is Jesus: the Eucharist is everything.

The feast of Corpus Christi is a reminder and a celebration of God’s gift of himself to us and a pledge of eternal life and resurrection. This is our faith and our hope.

“You are what you eat” – “I am the Bread, the Bread of Life”.
